

# Uno

**Finished Size** 8 ¼" bust circumference

**Yarn** Sirdar Snuggley Magic DK (55% Nylon, 45% Acrylic; 191yd [175 m]/50 g): (Dark blue and light blue stripes) 2 skeins.

**Needles** Size 3 (3 ¼ mm): straight needles. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.

**Notions** Tapestry needle. 2 Buttons.

**Gauge** 29 sts and 37 rows = 4" in St st.



## Back

CO 55 sts.

Row 1: (RS) \*K3, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: \*K2, p3; rep from \* to end of row.

Rep these 2 rows 2 more times.

Beg with a RS row, work even in St st until piece measures 5 ¾" (15 cm) from CO, ending with WS row.

**Shape armholes:** BO 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows – 51 sts rem. Dec 1 st each end of needle on the next 3 rows – 45 sts rem. Cont even in St st for 18 rows.

**Shape neck and shoulders:** Mark center 17 sts for back neck. Next row: (WS) BO 3 sts, purl to marked center sts, join second ball of yarn and BO center 17 sts, purl to last 3 sts. BO rem 3 sts – 11 sts rem on each side of neck. Work each side separately. *Note:* Neck shaping is introduced while shoulder shaping is still in progress; read the next section all the way through before proceeding. At each armhole edge, BO 3 sts once. *At the same time*, at each neck edge, BO 2 sts once – 6 sts rem on each side of neck. BO rem 6 sts.

**Back neckband:** *Note:* The neckband starts at the top right shoulder and goes all the way across the top to the left shoulder. With RS facing, and beg at right shoulder, pick up 45 sts across back.

Row 1: (WS) \*K2, p3; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: \*K3, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

Rep these 2 rows 2 more times. BO all sts.

## Front

CO 55 sts.

Row 1: (RS) \*K3, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: \*K2, p3; rep from \* to end of row.

Rep these 2 rows 2 more times.

Beg with a RS row, work even in St st until piece measures 5 ¾" (15 cm) from CO, ending with WS row.

**Shape armholes:** BO 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows – 51 sts rem. Dec 1 st each end of needle on the next 3 rows – 45 sts rem. Cont even in St st for 10 rows.

**Shape neck and shoulders:** Mark center 17 sts for back neck. Next row: (WS) Purl to marked center sts, join second ball of yarn and BO center 17 sts, purl to end of row – 14 sts rem on each side of neck. Work each side separately. Cont even in St st while doing neck shaping. On next 2 WS rows, at each neck edge, BO 1 st – 12 sts rem on each side of neck. Next WS row, at neck edge, BO 2 sts – 10 sts rem on each side of neck. BO 10 sts.

**Front neckband:** *Note: The neckband starts at the top left shoulder and goes all the way across the top to the rightt shoulder.* With RS facing, and beg at left shoulder, pick up 55 sts across front.

Row 1: (WS) \*K2, p3; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: \*K3, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 3: K2, p2, yo twice, p1. \*K2, p3; rep from \* till 5 sts rem. K1, yo twice, k1, p3.

Row 4: P2, k5. \*P2, k3; rep from \* till 7 sts rem. P4, k3.

Row 5: K2, p1, p2tog, p2tog, \*K2, p3; rep from \* till 7 sts rem. K2tog, k2tog, p3.

Row 6: \*K3, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

BO all sts.

### **Sleeves**

CO 30 sts.

Row 1: (RS) \*K3, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: \*K2, p3; rep from \* to end of row.

Rep these 2 rows 2 more times.

Beg with a RS row, work even in St st for 43 rows. On row 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28, 32, 36, and 40 inc 1 st at each end of sleeve.

Cont in St st till end of sleeve.

Dec 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of sleeve for 5 rows – 34 sts rem.

Dec 2 sts at both ends of next 2 rows – 26 sts rem. Dec 3 sts at both ends of sleeve. – 20 sts rem. Dec 4 sts at both ends of sleeve – 12 sts rem. BO all sts.

### **Finishing**

Block pieces. With yarn threaded on a tapestry needle, sew front neckband over back neckband at shoulder edges. Sew sleeve caps into armholes, aligning center of each sleeve cap with shoulder seam. Sew sleeve and side seams. Attach buttons to back neckband.
